- To strengthen student government structures at KPCE.

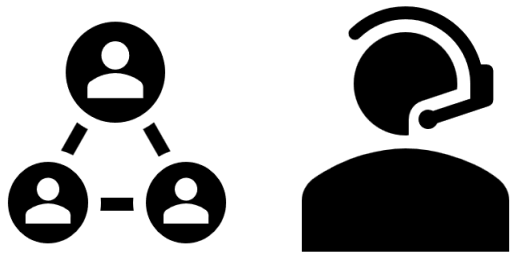
Why

- To support KPCE in ensuring students' voices are heard and can contribute to how the college provides learning opportunities.

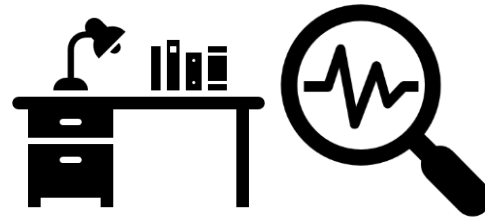
How

Conversations with key stakeholders on the Ashesi Campus via phone and zoom conferencing



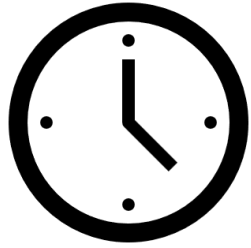
Extensive research



Needs assessment and virtual focus group discussions



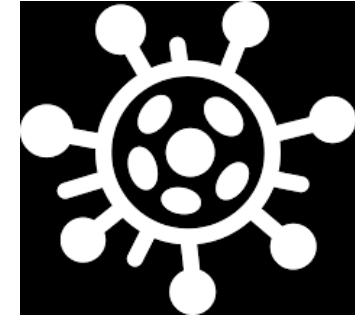
Challenges and Mitigation Factors

Insufficient sample size for needs assessment



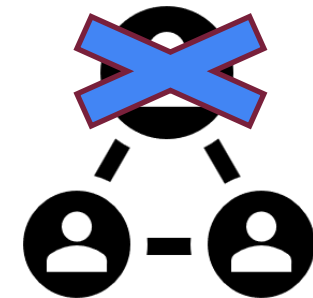
COVID-19 restrictions



Insufficient time for training program

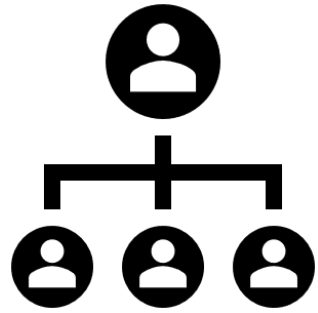


Dealing with new mindsets about the topic
